SAMPSON COUNTY CONVENTION & VISITORS BUREAU ANNOUNCES OPEN ENROLLMENT FOR THE EVENT MARKETING GRANT PROGRAM FROM JUNE 1, 2019 - JUNE 30, 2019 3RD Application Cycle

Event Marketing Grant Program developed to assist in promoting events and attraction across Sampson County

(Sampson County, NC) -- The Sampson County Convention & Visitors Bureau (SCCVB) announced today that open enrollment for the 3rd Application Cycle that will start effective June 1, 2019 and will run through June 30, 2019 for all Event Marketing Grant Applications. All applications must be postmarked by June 30, 2019 to be considered in the third application cycle of 2019.

The Event Marketing Grant Program was developed to assist Sampson County organizations in the promotion of special events and visitor attractions, and to further stimulate economic growth within the County by supporting non-profit organizations and visitor attractions that are in Sampson County that sponsor special events or those that manage local visitor attractions.

"We are always excited when we (SCCVB) can provide funding to allow additional marketing and advertising for our Sampson County festivals and events, which will in turn attract more visitors to our county" stated Ms. Sheila Barefoot, Executive Director, Sampson County Convention and Visitors Bureau. All Event Grant Marketing funds awarded can only be used for the marketing, advertising or promotion of special events or local attractions that are being promoted in media markets located outside of Sampson County.

The SCCVB Event Marketing Grant committee processes EMG Applications four times per fiscal year (January, April, July & October) or until such time that the annual allocation is exhausted. Cycles for the applications are as follows:

January - 1st Cycle - Applications may be submitted December 1st - December 31th April - 2nd Cycle - Applications may be submitted March 1st - March 31st July - 3rd Cycle - Applications may be submitted June 1st - June 30th October - 4th Cycle - Applications may be submitted September 1st - September 30th

All applications must be postmarked no later than December 31st to be considered for the first cycle, March 31st to be considered for the 2nd cycle, June 30th to be considered for the 3rd cycle and September 30th to be considered for the 4th cycle.

Organizations that may apply for EMGP funding include any legally chartered 501-(c3) non-profit Sampson County organization or chartered municipality representing a visitor attraction or large special events that strive to promote tourism within the County by attracting visitors. Documentation of legal status, tax exemption, federal identification number, budget, and organizational purpose are required with all applications.

Funding for the SCCVB EMGP is provided through room occupancy taxes (ROT) that are collected by Sampson County's lodging establishments which are generated as a result of overnight lodging by visitors to Sampson County. The SCCVB has tentatively allocated \$3,000 for the upcoming Fiscal Year budget towards the Event Marketing Grant Program.

The Sampson County CVB was approved and enacted to be a public authority established through legislation by the General Assembly of the State of North Carolina and adopted, approved, and enacted by the Sampson County Board of Commissioners with the purpose of promoting the development of travel and tourism related activities in Sampson County, through state, regional and national advertising, marketing and promotional activities and campaigns.
